The stay-at-home orders of the COVID-19 crisis continues to have a life-threatening impact for families who are struggling to put food on the table. We are praying for the decisions being made by governments around the world that they will be granted wisdom on how to move forward with the least amount of lives lost. All our international directors have been in touch with local government officials to see how they can help during this time of need.

The South Africa Super Kitchen partnered with their province's social service department to distribute 700,000 portions of porridge to families in Fisantekraal, a low-income housing area

close to Cape Town (the pallets of porridge are pictured above). It took two semi-trucks and an armed escort to make sure it arrived safely. Once delivered to a central location, the porridge was distributed by pastors and volunteers to the 7,000 families in need.

A week later, another 3 tons (6,000 pounds) of porridge was picked up. But get this, the people who made the deliveries to families in the township of Manenberg, are gang members who have called a ceasefire during this lockdown. This week the South Africa Super Kitchen opened its doors to the public with the launch of the OTB Food Factory Shop. They share, "During the global COVID-19 pandemic, the need for affordable groceries became evident as the pandemic caused many people to lose their income. Our aim is to serve that market. Proceeds generated by the shop will in turn fund our non-profit organization who strives to feed the hungry."

The shop includes well-priced necessities including canned food, long-life milk, rice, salt, sugar, macaroni, maize, porridge, freshly baked bread, and more. It is open to the public Monday-Saturday!
